Volunteer Code of Conduct

- Follow and respect instructions from FareShare staff;
- Act as good role models and ambassadors for FareShare at all times;
- Approach all tasks with a positive attitude;
- Always treat fellow volunteers, FareShare staff and supporters with respect and dignity;
- Never use offensive language or behavior;
- Respect the rights and worth of every person regardless of their age, gender, sexuality, ability, cultural background or religion.
